In just five decades it has grown into a large educational complex with 34 institutions catering to diverse fields of education such as Humanities, Engineering, Education, Medicine, Management, Pure Sciences and Mass Communication, with more than 39000+ Candidates and 3000+ Faculties and staff on a throbbing 65 acre campus.

The Somaiya Vidyavihar Complex was founded in 1959 by late Shri K.J. Somaiya (1902-1999). Endowed with a sharp business acumen, a balanced perspective and a social bent of mind, Karamshibhai set up the Somaiya Trust in 1953 for furthering his dream of shaping young minds through quality education. For this purpose, he bought a large area of land at Ghatkopar, then considered to be distant, meagrely populated. In the words of Swami Vivekananda, “We want that education by which character is formed, strength of mind is increased, and the intellect expanded, and by which one can stand on one’s own feet.” We have now grown into a multi-disciplinary and multi-campus education institution with over 1500 faculty, and 38, 000 candidates.

Rooted in the University's guiding philosophy, "Knowledge Alone Liberates", the School is committed to fostering critical inquiry, multilingual competence, cultural rootedness, and intellectual rigour, in alignment with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

KJSSLL offers a wide range of postgraduate, diploma, certificate, and doctoral programmes, and nurtures scholars capable of contributing meaningfully to academia, cultural institutions, education, publishing, translation, and the creative industries. In keeping with this research-driven vision, the PhD Programme in Marathi Language and Literature, launched in the Academic Year 2025–2026, marks a significant milestone in the School's academic growth. The programme is designed to promote rigorous and original research into the rich linguistic, literary, and cultural traditions of Marathi. The recognition of Marathi as a Classical Language by the Government of India in 2024 further underscores the importance of advanced scholarly engagement in documenting, interpreting, and re-evaluating its classical, medieval, modern, and contemporary literary corpus.

Building on this strong foundation, the School proposes to introduce **PhD programmes in English Language and Literature** in the Academic Year 2026–2027. These programmes aim to expand the School's doctoral research profile by facilitating advanced inquiry into Indian, global, and comparative literary studies, critical theory, language studies, and literature as a site of cultural and social transformation. Together, these doctoral programmes reflect KJSSLL's commitment to nurturing independent researchers, critical thinkers, and knowledge producers who can engage meaningfully with both regional specificity and global academic discourse.

Ph.D. Admission Eligibility for Somaiya Vidyavihar University (SVU): Minimum Qualifications for Admission

Subject to the conditions stipulated in the Regulations, the following candidate are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. Programme

i.	Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent as per UGC regulations.
ii.	A person whose master's dissertation has been evaluated, and the viva-voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. Programme but subject to completion of master's degree before provisional admission to SVU Ph.D. Programmes.
iii.	Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to Master's Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. Programme.
iv.	MUST have qualified the Ph.D. Entrance Examination and interview of SVU – mandatory eligibility criteria for all candidates.
v.	Candidates exempted from appearing for Ph.D. Entrance Examination of SVU MUST fill the application form as per the schedule displayed on website. The exempted candidates need to pay the application processing fee .
vi.	A No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer in case of those who are working / employed for applying to Ph.D. Programme
vii	If candidate wants to apply more than one subject then should submit separate / another application and need to pay the application processing fee per subject.

Graduation Degree	Double Major or Single Major in Literature and Anthropology/ Sociology/ History/ Political Science/ Psychology/ Philosophy/ Archaeology/ Economics/ Culture Studies/ Mass Media OR Liberal Arts/ Liberal Studies OR Eligibility requires the successful completion of at least one course in English Language and Literature in any Graduate Degree recognised by the UGC
Post-Graduation Degree	MA/ MSc. in English or English Language and Literature or MA/ MSc. in Literature OR Double Major or Single Major in Literature and Anthropology/ Sociology/ History/ Political Science/ Psychology/ Philosophy/ Archaeology/ Economics/ Culture Studies/ Mass Media OR Liberal Arts (Major in Literature) recognised by the UGC

Exemption Criteria for SVU Ph.D. Entrance Examination

Candidates who hold a JRF Fellowship with CSIR/UGC/ICAR/ ICMR and DBT examinations **are exempted** from appearing for Ph.D. entrance examination of SVU.
